University of Denver Golf Club at Highlands Ranch Ladies 9-Hole and 18-Hole Golf Leagues 2025 General Information

Our goal is to provide a competitive, but fun social setting to meet new ladies who enjoy golf while providing an opportunity to learn the rules and etiquette of golf.

Our Golf League is comprised of two different options for leagues: a 9-hole league on Wednesday afternoons (3:30 – 6:00 PM) and an 18-hole league on Saturday mornings (8:30 - 10 AM).

The leagues start off with a combined kick off breakfast in April and conclude with a banquet in September.

During the year, our leagues have fun events including:

- Game of the Day
- 9-Hole League Fun Day Scramble
- 18-Hole League 6 Club Challenge
- Team Match Play Tournament (open to 9 & 18-Hole League Members)
- 2-day League Championship for both leagues
- Invited to play in the Old Glory Tournament on July 3rd

In the 9-hole league, we play every Wednesday from the end of April through the beginning of September. All players play the red tees. You can sign up 1 week in advance using Golf Genius, starting at 9 AM along with one other lady for each play day. We typically play the front nine, however, we play the back nine on the first Wednesday of each month. All prizes are paid out in Golf Shop Credit for Game of the Day/Low Gross/Low Net for 3 flights. Each player (with an established handicap) must pay a \$5 fee for Game of the Day, and you must have an established handicap to win Game of the Day and/or Low Net.

In the 18-hole league, we play 10 Saturdays starting the beginning of May and ending the beginning of September. At the beginning of the season, you can choose to play either the silver or red tees and you must play from that tee box for the season. You can sign up 2 weeks in advance, using Golf Genius, starting at 6 AM with three other ladies for each play day. All prizes are paid out in Golf Shop Credit for Game of the Day/Low Gross/Low Net for 2 flights (red & silver). Each player (with an established handicap) must pay a \$5 fee for Game of the Day, and you must have an established handicap to win Game of the Day and/or Low Net.

NOTE - Currently both the 9-hole and 18-hole leagues are full, contact Susan Horton SKHorton77@outlook.com to be put on the waiting list.

To participate fully in the leagues, each member must:

1) Sign up through the DUGC website and pay the league fee of \$135/league.

- 2) Pay to activate your GHIN handicap account (or open one if you don't have one). If you are a member of the DUGC, the fee is \$55 and if you are not a member, the fee is \$65. You must call the Pro Shop, 303-471-0000 to activate your GHIN. If you have a GHIN at another golf course the price at DUGC is \$43. Per the Colorado Golf Association, each league you play in requires you to activate your GHIN at that course. Note If you are new to the handicap system, once you have the account set-up, you must enter three 18-hole rounds or six 9-hole rounds to establish your handicap. We strongly encourage new members to play as many rounds as they can outside of league play to establish a handicap quickly.
- 3) Register on the Golf Genuis app to sign up for tee times and enter scores.

Additional costs include applicable greens fees, cart (optional) and the \$5 Game of the Day fee. You will pay these costs each league day that you play. Please call the Pro Shop to inquire about the DUGC 10-Round Pass that may offer you additional savings.
